- GREEN LOOP ELEMENTS:**
- CANAL BANK FROM LOCK LANE TO RED BROOK (F-G)**
 - Improved public bridleway
 - Flowering meadows
 - Improved woodland
 - New hedgerow
- LOCK LANE TO CORONERS WOOD EAST (G-H)**
 - Widened and improved public footpath within Coroners Wood
 - New informal footpath through recreation ground
 - Selective thinning and enrichment of trees within Coroners Wood
 - Improved wildlife habitats including log piles, bird and bat boxes
- RED BROOK NATURE TRAIL (H-I)**
 - Widened and improved public footpath
 - Existing woodland maintained and enriched
 - Proposed wildflower grassland
 - Improved wildlife habitats including log piles, bird and bat boxes
 - Dipping platforms and interpretive boards providing an educational resource
- SOUTH OF BROADOAK SCHOOL (J-K)**
 - New / widened existing public footpath
 - New hedgerow
 - Maintained and enriched young plantation
 - Proposed native tree and shrub planting
 - Improved wildlife habitats including log piles, bird and bats boxes
- CROSS LANE EAST (K-L)**
 - Planting of additional large trees
 - Existing plantation enriched and managed
 - Improved wildlife habitats including log piles, bird and bat boxes
- LINKING PATHS (L-D)**
 - A waymarked and pleasant roadside eastern link 2000m long connecting the north and south off road sections of the Green Loop
- MANCHESTER ROAD TO SHIP CANAL (D-M)**
 - New footpath connection between Manchester Road and Ship Canal
 - Improved public footpath along canal bank
 - New hedgerow planting
- LINKING PATHS (N, O, P)**
 - 500m of improved footpath links connecting the canal bank, Scroggins Lane, Hall Lane and River Lane
- PHASED DEVELOPMENT OF CANALSIDE PROMENADE (G-T-S-R-Q-M)**
 - Eventual total of 1,450m length of inviting safe public footpath with excellent views up and down the canal
 - Planting of circa 140 large trees along promenade
